

The following are instructions on how to create an Oregon Care Partners account and enroll in the Let’s Get Real modules using Oregon Care Partners online training dashboard, powered by Relias.

### Continuing Education Unit (CEU) Certificates

CEU certificates for online classes must be printed from your [Oregon Care Partners](#) account.

[Login](#) to your Oregon Care Partners account, in the top right navigation bar under your name, select “My Dashboard” from the drop-down menu options. Find the section titled “My Completed Classes”, select “print certificate” to the right of the class details to view, download, and print your certificate.



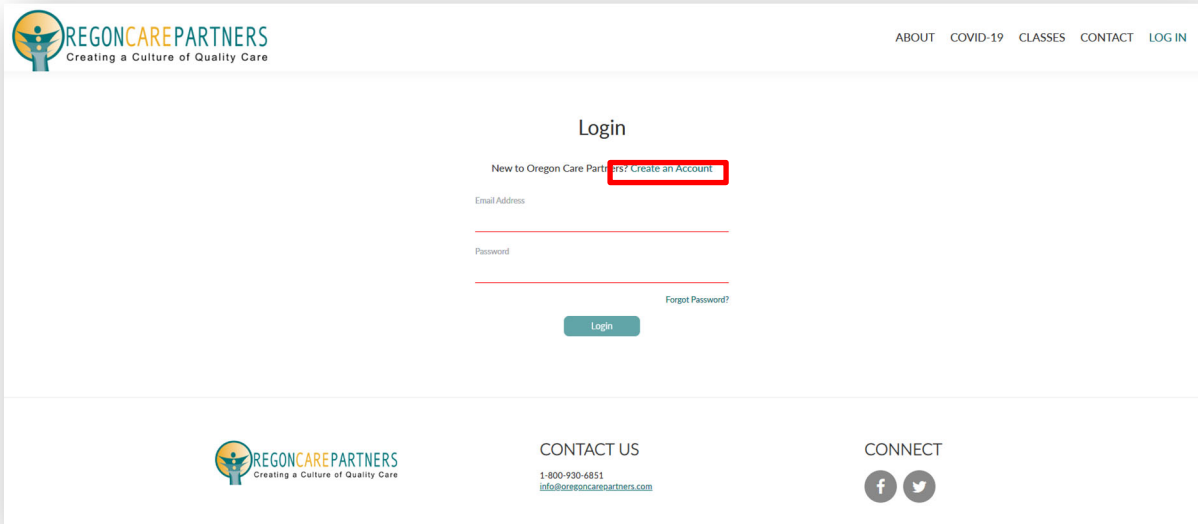

## Create an Account

From the [Oregon Care Partners login page](#), select Create an Account.



1. Complete the Create an Account form and select “Next”
2. Choose the Caregiver Type that best describes your primary role as a caregiver
3. Check the boxes at the bottom of the page to confirm you live or work in Oregon and agree to our [Terms of Use](#) and [Privacy Policy](#), click “Create Account”
4. Go to your email inbox to find the account verification email
5. Click “Verify Email Address” to verify your email address and activate your account (If you cannot locate your verification email, please check your junk mail and spam folders and add [info@oregoncarepartners.com](mailto:info@oregoncarepartners.com) to your “Safe” or “Preferred Sender” list.)

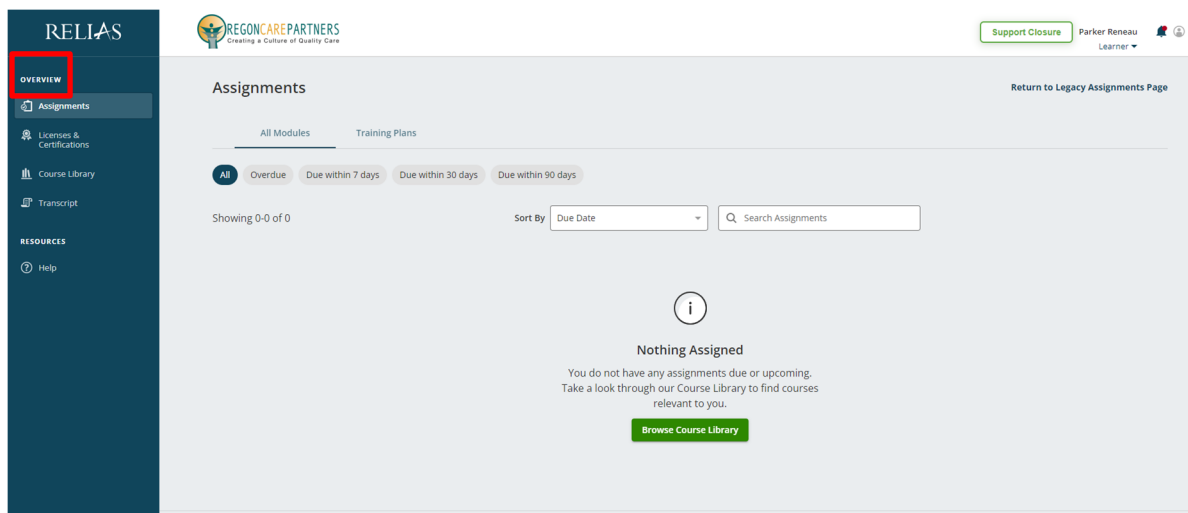

**Assignments** – The main screen you will use to access training within Relias

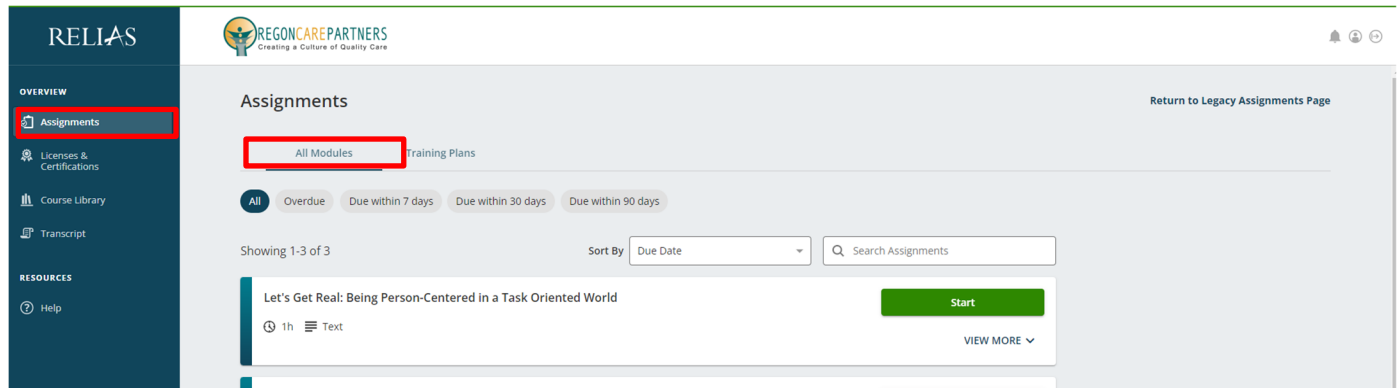
**Licenses and Certifications** – Adding a license or certification in the Licenses & Certifications page is optional and not required to take Oregon Care Partners online classes in Relias

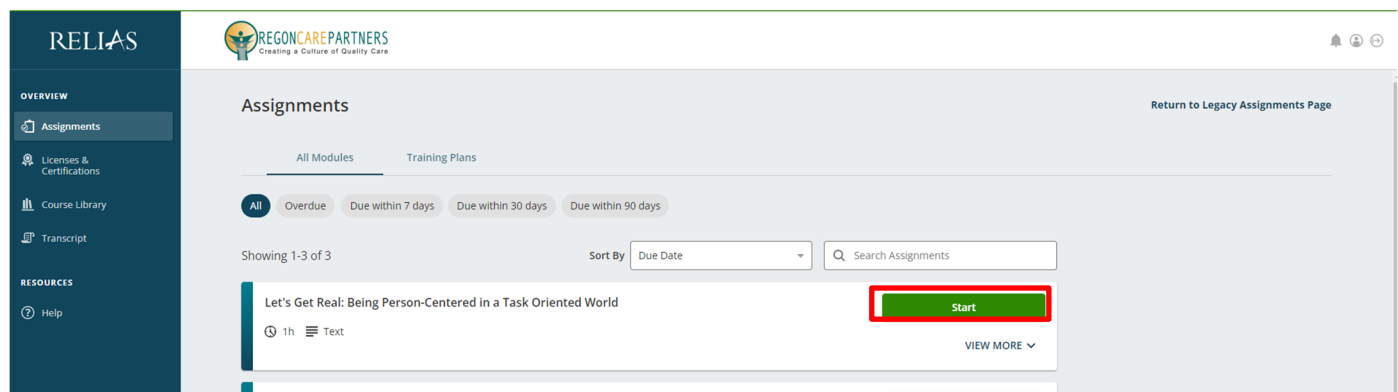

## Navigating Through an Online Class

To launch an online class, click **Start** or select the class title on the **All Modules** page.




Next, you will see Lessons and Exams, there may be one or multiples of each. Some courses may not require an exam or an evaluation.

If you need to stop a lesson partway through, click **Exit** or **X** to save your progress and then logout of Relias. You can continue where you left off when you return.





### Final Exam:

### Online Class Player Features:

## HELP

MENU	<b>MENU:</b> Displays all the topics in the course. Your current topic will be highlighted in the menu.
NOTES	<b>NOTES:</b> Displays the audio that is currently playing.
HELP	<b>HELP:</b> Displays the navigational features of the course.
RESOURCES	<b>RESOURCES:</b> Allows you to view and download any supported resources for the course. Courses without resources will not have this option available.
EXIT	<b>EXIT:</b> Allows you to exit the course. When exiting the course always use the course EXIT button to ensure that your progress is saved.
< PREV NEXT >	<b>PREV / NEXT:</b> Allows you to navigate to the previous/next screens within the course.

-  **VOLUME:** Allows you to control the volume.
-  **PLAY / PAUSE:** Allows you to play/pause the screen.
-  **PROGRESS BAR:** Shows the progress of the current screen.
-  **REPLAY:** Allows you to replay the screen.
